

General notes and instructions for the visit to the company museum

At Rolls-Royce Deutschland, Willy-Seck-Str. 1, 61440 Oberursel.

The museum is open normally from January to November on the last Friday of each month, excluding public holidays and bridging days, from 15.00 to 18.00 Hrs.

The visit to the works museum on general opening days is provided as a guided tour only. Booking is possible in advance by email and confirmation (Time-frame ticket). Register at least two days prior to the date of the desired visit.

You will be informed if spaces are available on the requested date. The number of visitors is limited to 6 persons. Guided tours take place at 15:00 and 16:30 on general opening days respectively.

The minimum age for visitors to the museum is 14 years; the museum is not barrier-free and is only partially suitable for people with a reduced mobility. Since the museum is located on the Rolls-Royce site, access for visitors from "risk states" cannot be granted in every case.

An official ID card (identity card, passport, etc.) must be presented before being granted access to the site.

A visit to the museum is only possible under the following pre-requisites during the ongoing pandemic:

- Wearing of an FFP2 face mask
- Presentation of a negative Covid test (PoC-Antigen-quick test or a PCR test), which may not be older than 24 hours when entering the premises or
- Proof of a completed second vaccination (15 days after the second vaccination) or
- Presentation of a PCR test certification, which confirms the recovery from a covid infection and is older than 28 days, but not older than 6 months
- Presentation of a PCR test, which confirms the recovery from a covid infection and is older than 6 months plus a vaccination certificate confirming the first vaccination

For the purpose of tracking possible routes of infection (and also for entry into the factory premises), Rolls-Royce Germany is obliged to collect the following data from each visitor:

Pre-register at the latest two days prior to the date of the desired visit.

Fact sheet for visitors to the Works Museum.

Due to its location within a secure area of the Rolls-Royce site, museum visits can only take place in accordance with certain rules and regulations. Furthermore, the well-being and safety of visitors and employees are very important to us.

These instructions are handed to you or have been read to you at the reception. Please read and observe them fully when entering the factory premises:

Access to the factory premises and the museum is permitted only:

- When pre-registered by email.
- After registration at the reception where an ID card, passport or similar is to be presented. Furthermore, a Covid document is to be presented.
- When accompanied at all times by a company employee or a designated representative
- After receiving instructions in health and safety (in accordance with this fact sheet)
- After receiving the visitors' pass and after reading the "Instructions for visitors to the company museum"
- Entrance to the factory premises is at your own risk and of your own free will. The factory premises and the museum are not barrier-free. For visitors to the museum, the visit is permitted only in and around the museum as well as on the direct way to and from the museum.
- The visitors' badge must be carried visibly at all times.

An FFP2 face mask must be worn at all times during the stay on the factory premises and particularly when in the buildings. A minimum distance of 1,5 metres must be maintained at all times. The formation of groups is not permitted. Distancing is to be maintained when seated in the exhibition area and in the area of the toilets.

Due diligence applies when on the factory premises. Be especially aware of vehicles (forklifts, etc.). Use the pavements or walk along the side of the road.

No liability is assumed for personal items and valuables.

The minimum age for museum visitors is 14 years. (In exceptional cases below this age when accompanied by a legal representative. The form "Legally binding declaration to Rolls-Royce Deutschland Ltd & Co KG" must be completed and signed by the legal representative.)

The museum is not barrier-free and only partially suitable to persons with a reduced mobility.

Since the museum is located on the Rolls-Royce site, access for visitors from "risk states" cannot be granted in every case.

The carrying of dangerous articles and dangerous substances is forbidden. It is not permitted to bring animals onto the site.

Smoking is not permitted on the company premises. (Smoking is, however, permitted in designated smoking areas only).

Photography and filming are not permitted on the company premises. Photography is allowed within the area of the museum after previous consultation with the accompanying company representative.

Data protection notice for photo and film recordings and their use: We regularly take photos and films at our events, some of which are published on our homepage, on our social media channels and, if necessary, in other publications. Please inform the photographer on site if you do not wish to have the photo/film containing your image published.

Please do not touch the exhibits as there is a danger of injury, contamination and or damage.

Please obey the instructions of the company representative.

Please return the visitor's badge back to the reception when exiting the premises.
