

Visit to the factory museum "Motorenfabrik Oberursel" in the Günter-Kappler-Haus

On the site of Rolls-Royce Deutschland, Willy-Seck-Str. 1, 61440 Oberursel

General notes

- ♦ The museum is open from January to November on the last Friday of each month, excluding public holidays and bridging days, from 15.00 to 18.00 Hrs and can be visited as a guided tour. Guided tours are offered from 15:00 to 16:30 hours.
- ♦ Group tours at other times are possible and can be booked on request. Contact: info@gkmo.net
- ♦ Entrance fee: 2,50 per person. Donations welcome.
Contribution for group tours at other times by prior arrangement.
- ♦ The minimum age for visitors to the museum is 14 years. Children from 7 years on are permitted to visit the museum provided they are accompanied by a legal representative. The duty of supervision and liability lies with the child's legal representative.
- ♦ The museum is not barrier-free and is only partially suitable for people with a reduced mobility.
- ♦ Access to the Rolls-Royce site for visitors from "risk states" cannot be granted in every case.
- ♦ An official ID card (identity card, passport, etc.) must be presented before being granted access to the site.
- ♦ Information on data protection of Rolls-Royce Deutschland for the museum visit can be viewed at the reception or will be sent on request.

The information and regulations listed in the Visitor Regulations (leaflet) apply.

Visitor Regulations

Due to its location within a secure area of the Rolls-Royce site, museum visits can only take place in accordance with certain rules and regulations. Furthermore, the well-being and safety of visitors and employees are very important to us.

Please observe the following instructions handed out to you or read to you at the reception. You accept these instructions unreservedly when entering the factory premises:

- Access to the factory premises and the museum is permitted:
 - After registration at the reception where an ID card, passport or similar is to be presented.
 - When accompanied at all times by a company employee or a designated representative
 - After receiving safety instructions (in accordance with this leaflet)
 - After receiving the visitors' pass and after reading the "Notice for visitors to the works museum"
 - Entrance to the factory premises is at your own risk and of your own free will. The factory premises and the museum are not barrier-free. For visitors to the museum, the visit is permitted only in and around the museum as well as on the direct way to and from the museum.
 - The visitors' badge must be carried visibly at all times.

- The current rules on hygiene for the Rolls-Royce Deutschland site in Oberursel apply.

- Information on data protection of Rolls-Royce Deutschland for the museum visit can be viewed at the reception or will be sent on request.

- Due diligence applies when on the factory premises. Be especially aware of vehicles (forklifts, etc.). Use the pavements or walk along the side of the road.

- No liability is assumed for personal items and valuables.

- The minimum age for visitors to the museum is 14 years. Children from 7 years on are permitted to visit the museum provided they are accompanied by a legal representative. The duty of supervision and liability lies with the child's legal representative.

- The museum is not barrier-free and only partially suitable for persons with a reduced mobility.

- Since the museum is located on the Rolls-Royce site, access for visitors from "risk states" cannot be granted in every case.

- The carrying of dangerous articles and dangerous substances is forbidden. It is not permitted to bring animals onto the site.

- Smoking is not permitted on the company premises. Smoking is permitted, however, in designated smoking areas only).

- Photography and filming are not permitted on the company premises. Photography is allowed within the area of the museum after previous consultation with the accompanying company representative.

- During the visit to the museum and events, photographs and film recordings may be made, in particular for the purpose of press and public relations work and historical documentation (for example, for publications of the society in documents or on the website, for disclosure to the press). The Historical Society consider the permission to publish as consented if you do not inform us at the time of registration, or at the latest three days prior to the museum visit otherwise.
- Please do not touch the exhibits as there is a danger of injury, contamination and or damage.
- Please obey the instructions of the company representative.
- Please return the visitor's badge back to the reception when exiting the premises.
